Enoxaparin (Lovenox®) is administered only by injection under the skin using a small needle and syringe. Injections can be given once or twice a day.

Lovenox is given by an injection under the skin (subcutaneously) near an area on the right or left side of your stomach. Lovenox should not be given into the muscle. Specific injections instructions are given on the next page. What are potential adverse effects? As with all anticoagulants, bleeding is the major adverse effect of Lovenox. ...

As a healthcare professional, you have familiarized yourself with the important facts about administering enoxaparin (Lovenox). As you will recall, Lovenox is used to prevent deep venous thrombosis by preventing clots from forming. The drug may also be used for other conditions determined by the physician.

How to plan and manage your Heparin injections. The preferred site of injection is the abdominal area. Injections must be given 2 inches away from the umbilicus (see diagram). If you need another area to inject your Heparin, you may use your thighs or buttocks. Rotate your sites of injections. Avoid injecting a bruised area.

Lovenox burns. The slower you go, the less it burns. Also, some injection sites just burn less than others. The ice in step one helps with the burn. 6. Wait - Press the plunger all the way to the bottom of the syringe and hold it there for about 10 seconds. If you remove the needle too soon, you'll get blood and/or Lovenox leaking out.

Your Care Instructions. Heparin is an anticoagulant medicine given as a shot (injection). Your doctor may have given you low-molecular-weight heparin. Anticoagulants are often called blood thinners. They prevent new blood clots from forming and keep existing clots from getting larger. At first, you may be nervous about giving yourself a shot.

### How to Give a Heparin Shot: Care Instructions

A subcutaneous injection is an injection administered into the fatty area just under the skin. Because they give a slower, more gradual release than intravenous injections, subcutaneous injections are frequently used as a way to administer both vaccines and medications (for instance, type I diabetics often use this type of injection to administer insulin.).
