Chapter 18.04 RCW: ACCOUNTANCY

A firm of certified public accountants or public accountants engaged in the practice of public accountancy pursuant to subdivision three of section seventy-four hundred one of this article, but not engaged in the practice of public accountancy pursuant to subdivisions one and two of section seventy-four hundred one of this article, may register with the department under this subdivision.

NYS Public Accountancy:Laws, Rules & Regulations:Article 149

(1A) In this Act, a reference to improper conduct by, of or on the part of a public accountant, an accounting corporation, an accounting firm or an accounting LLP includes any breach of any code of professional conduct and ethics prescribed by rules made under section 64, including any code of professional conduct and ethics adopted by reference in those rules.
